



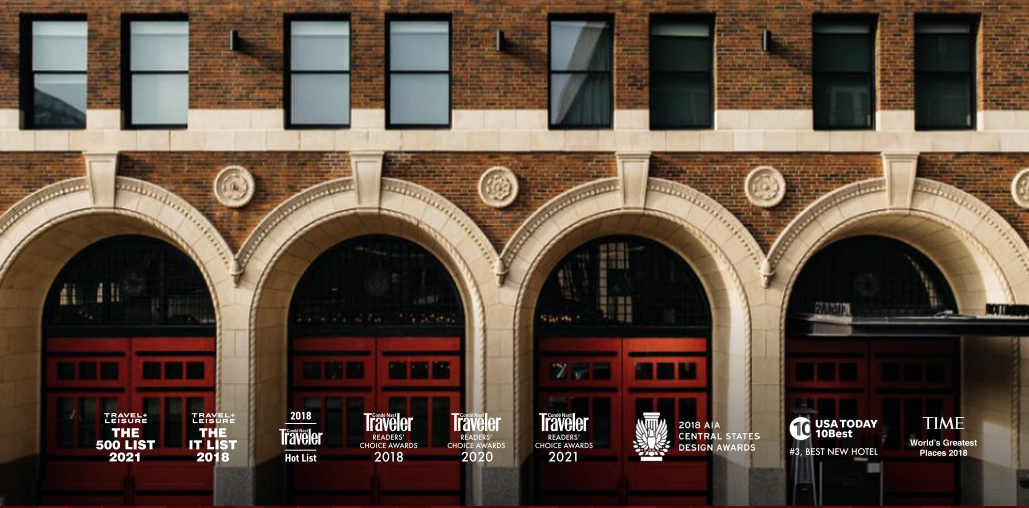

Blending industrial design with exceptional luxury, the spectacular event space at the Foundation features private dining, locally curated art and cutting-edge technology.

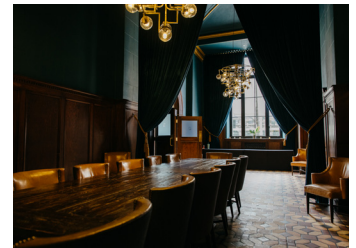

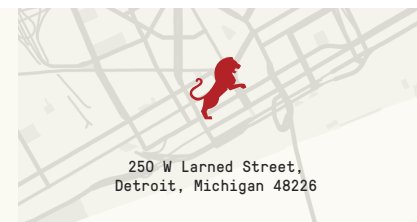
